### WHAT NOT TO BRING

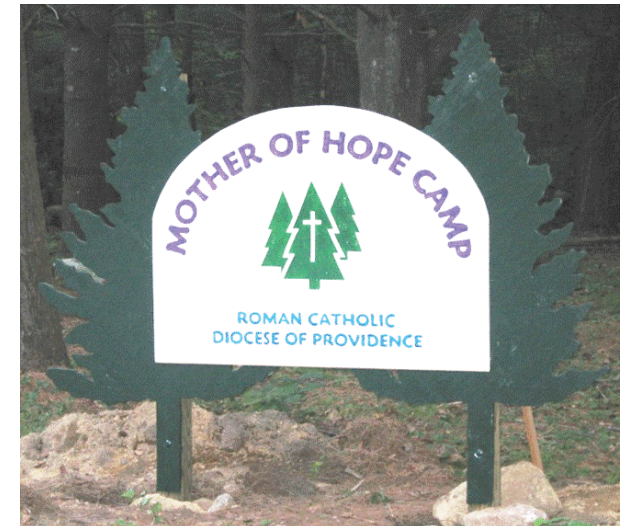
Fire arms Dangerous games

## Rental Guidelines

The facilities of the Mother of Hope property are available for daily rental and retreats by parishes and groups affiliated with the Diocese of Providence.

- The rental fee is to be paid in full at the time of the event. Should the reservation be canceled, the rental fee will only be refunded if the facilities are rented by another party for the same day.
- In the event of continued persistent inclement weather which prevents the use of the facilities, the rental fee will be refunded or arrangements can be made for an alternate date.
- The security deposit is to be paid in full at least one week prior to the reserved date and shall be refunded in full, less any costs for damages or facility clean-up, within two weeks after the reservation date.
- Each group shall designate in writing the name of two individuals who will represent the group and be responsible for overall coordination.
- The contact person shall bring and have available at all times a current list of participants that includes: names and addresses, emergency contact information, and known allergies or health conditions.



- A signed form granting permission to seek emergency treatment is required for each participant under the age of 18 and not accompanied by their parent or guardian.
- Each group shall provide, at their cost, certified lifeguard services as follows:  
Group size up to 50: 1 lifeguard  
Group size over 50: 2 lifeguards

**NOTE:** Copies of current certifications, lifeguard training, first aid, CPR and state life guard certification must reach the camp two weeks prior to the rental date for each lifeguard.

Said lifeguard shall be in complete control and has responsibility of all water activities.



### **Consideration:**

We expect respect for the occupants of the private residence and the neighbors. Please be considerate in keeping the music volume to a minimum. Please leave the camp grounds as neat and clean as you found it.

Dogs are allowed only under the following conditions:

Be a responsible dog owner.

Pick up dog's waste with a plastic bag and disposed in dumpster.

- Mother of Hope Camp does not provide medical supervision treatment, maintenance or dispensing of medications for rental groups.
- Each group agrees to furnish a qualified adult to provide basic health supervision. A qualified adult is at least 21 years of age and possesses at least a current certificate of training in the principles of first aid from a nationally-recognized provider and age-appropriate CPR from a nationally recognized provider.
- The rental group must bring their own first aid supplies and equipment. Groups are responsible for their own emergency transportation.
- Phone numbers and locations of local EMS providers, clinics, and hospitals are provided in confirmation information and also posted near all phones available to groups.
- **No Smoking is allowed on the Mother of Hope Camp property.**
- All refuse and debris are to be placed in the dumpster by the users prior to departure. Hot charcoal barrel is provided (do not dump charcoal in dumpster.)
